The Cable Natural History Museum visitation is growing by leaps and bounds and **we anticipate being very busy this summer!** In addition to looking for volunteers to help **greet visitors, offer programs and help in the Museum Shop**, we have the opportunity to **employ two workers** through two very different and exciting programs.

**For a TEEN/YOUNG ADULT:** The CEP (**Northwest Wisconsin Concentrated Employment Program, Inc.**) offers a Summer Youth Employment Program for **youth ages 14 – 24** and the Museum has applied to be a site for a youth worker. This program emphasizes real work expectations, an opportunity to explore careers of interest, increase awareness of services offered by our community, financial literacy training, academic improvement and social growth.

If approved, the Museum site will offer a **qualified youth 30 – 40 hours/week** of educational experiences in a variety of areas including retail, office skills, public relations, marketing, cataloging, computer skills or special events. **For a SENIOR:** The **Senior Community Service Employment Program** offered by Experience Works helps individuals **age 55 and older** benefit from training, counseling and community service assignments in faith-based and community organizations as they transition into the workforce. **Workers are paid minimum wage for and average of 20 hours per week by Experience Works.** The Museum is looking to become a host agency qualified to train a participant in a variety of areas including retail, office skills, public relations, marketing, cataloging, or computer skills to name a few.
