

## **Northwest Wisconsin CEP Interpreter and Educator Position:**

### Kids Fishing Day Event:

1. Assist kids with fishing, staff a booth/teach, fill in for others during breaks, or float and gather resources for booth educators.
2. Assist with event set-up, last minute preparation needs, and event clean-up and storage.
3. Event promotions.

### Interpretive Program Assistant:

Research, develop and present interactive interpretive programs for the public on a weekly basis to increase public awareness, appreciation and understanding of the cultural, historical, and natural resources.

1. Develop a variety of natural and cultural history programs using Center's educational resources and present as part of the Northwoods Adventure Series.
2. Provide assistance to UWEX educators for on-the-water programs such as the Voyageur canoe, kayak Estuary Adventures and Watershed Warriors focusing on issues such as invasive species, water quality, and habitat impairment.
3. Provide guided walks through the native gardens and Center boardwalk trails focusing on native plant communities and backyard gardening ideas visitors can do to attract and retain wildlife.
4. Provide impromptu interpretation in the Center's tower, gardens, and other strategic locations to present short 5-10 minute talks on current issues.
5. Prepare monthly press releases with program schedules and poster gathering points such as libraries and community centers.
6. Prepare and record radio announcements for the Visitor Center Traveler Information System 1610 AM radio station (weekly) and the Center's foyer Power Point program (monthly).
