



## **Summer Internship Position**

Wild Within, located in the northwoods of Ely, Minnesota, runs full time summer youth programs Monday through Friday, 7:00 am to 5:00 pm, with six core programming hours everyday. Core programming hours were created to provide opportunities for field trips, educational programs, and for children to get out in nature and ignite their wild within. The program has become a valuable, appreciated and well-respected entity in this small, but booming town at the end of the road. We also run three-day summer camps that focus on a combination of wilderness skills such as shelter building, orienteering, and survival skills, as well as, personal growth skills such as leadership, goal setting, and positive conflict resolution. Furthermore, we design and deliver weekly nature programs to various resorts in the area. Applicants should enjoy working with children ages 5 – 13, have a passion for the outdoors, a desire to learn, be creative, and to teach others about nature and the environment. Above all, applicants must have a positive attitude.

### **Job Description:**

Instructor Assistant: assist with programs and preparation, activities, meals, field trips, etc. Develop and deliver outdoor education programs and other various programs including creative art, fitness, and gardening.

Mentor to young children: creating activities that help them grow.

Delivering weekly nature programs at resorts may be possible.

Assist with Classroom Caretaker Duties: floors, bathrooms, kitchen clean up, etc.

The position is 35- 40 hours a week on average. A stipend and living quarters are included however, personal food, transportation to and from work and, utilities are not the responsibility of Wild Within.
